> While core funding does not make up a large percentage of any ESD budget, it provides the foundation on which all ESD service is built. For the NWESD, core funding is the catalyst that turns \$1 of funding into \$40 of service. Core funding ultimately generates revenue and service at no cost to the state. When core funding is reduced, students and taxpayers suffer - student services decrease and/or costs to the state increase.


