### **BACKGROUND**

Holocaust survivor Adolek Kohn danced at the gates of Auschwitz with his grandchildren to a song called "I Will Survive." It was placed on YouTube, and the offensive feelings came to the forefront.

#### **PROBLEM**

Is the videoed celebration "tasteless," almost sacrilege, or is it a way for a group of people to work through their past?

#### **SCENARIO**

Sixty-five years after WWII a playful approach to a Holocaust memory is always bound to offend someone, and it's really only acceptable coming from survivors or other Jews intending no offense.

#### **TASK**

In your town 25% of the citizens are, or had family members that are, holocaust survivors or losses.

You are a reporter for the local newspaper. You feel that this video is a form of celebration. You have to research the feelings of the survivors, historians, cultures affected, and citizens to explain your view to the editor, so that you may write an article that portrays this video as a celebration.
