




Eligibility Status for Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2015


Medicaid-Paid Deliveries by County Washington Women with Births in 2015







Number of Undocumented Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2015






Documented Status of Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2015
