OPEN DOORS ATTENDANCE AGREEMENT

To stay enrolled in the Skagit Open Doors program we agree that the following will take place and continue through the period the student is enrolled with Open Doors. We also understand that the student has the right to re-enroll in a traditional or alternative high school within the district at any time:

- Student must be in physical attendance at the Open Doors facility for a *minimum of two hours per week* and this attendance must be conducted at a one-time setting each week.
- 2) Student must complete a *minimum* of one Indicator of Academic Progress (IAP) every 3 months.

We encourage students to attend as much as possible within their schedule and they must demonstrate minimum weekly attendance and IAP progress. If participation and progress at the required levels are not attained the student will be *un-enrolled* from the **Open Doors program** and a new re-enrollment process will need to be completed.

A student who has an Individualized Educational Plan (IEP) will have their attendance and progress reviewed after the first one to two (1-2) months of initial enrollment to determine if the Open Doors program is the best placement option for the student's success.

Due to the minimal requirements and limited space in our program we want to support those students who value and fully participate in the **Open Doors program.**
